7/21/2020 13:17:46	How are you going to social distance and make sure these kids are safe?	Each day upon entering the building, all students and staff members will need to wear face masks or shields. Polaris will provide each student their mask for use to enter Polaris and a shield for use in the classroom and lab. Staff members will be assigned to designated student entrance doors to monitor the flow of student traffic using physical distancing requirements. Labs and classrooms will adhere to physical distancing requirements. Hand sanitizing and hand washing stations will be located at building entrances. Infrared temperature scanners will be located at each entrance to verify student and staff temperatures. Our school nurse will assist any student who may appear to have an elevated temperature. All drinking fountain spigots have been disconnected but individual water bottles may be filled using the bottle filling feature. Polaris has identified and purchased proper cleaning products and has established a cleaning protocol that meets safety standards established by the Cuyahoga County Health Department. Each classroom and lab will be equipped with cleaning wipes, hand sanitizer and extra face coverings. Students will sanitize their own face shields and workstations at the end of each day and will sanitize their hands between classroom and labs instruction. We will continue to monitor and follow all information, recommendations and mandates from federal, state and local authorities regarding Covid-19.
